The following services are provided by The College EC and MUST be booked direct with The College EC and in advance of the Championships. You will require the following details: Card/payment details – vehicle registration/details

STABLING There are a limited number of permanent (yard opposite side of road) plus temporary (in adjacent field) stables available at College EC and must be arranged direct. £65 for the duration – extra nights £15 per night.

PORTABLE STABLING & Fenced/Gated corrals. Portable stabling may be erected in the Horsebox Park Field only. There will be a charge of £25 for portable stabling for the duration of the event. Parking area MUST BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE with The College

ELECTRIC HOOKUP POINTS are available and must be booked in advance direct. **Only one vehicle per hook up.** These are £45 for the duration of the event. If you want to park any other vehicle at these points then you must book another hook up. ALL other vehicles MUST be parked within the car/horsebox park. This will be strictly enforced, anyone taking advantage will be asked to leave the showground.

You MUST report to the Stable Managers office upon arrival BEFORE parking up or you may be asked to move to another position as parking will be tight and must be regulated.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Remember to bring your horse/ponies **passports** these will be checked.

All horses/ponies must have up to date **equine flu vaccinations.**
SMALL PONIES must not exceed 112cm (11 hands) ponies close to the height limit MUST produce a current height certificate OR note from Veterinary stating size.

DEFINITION OF Young Driver (Junior) STATUS

Actual Age of Juniors on 1st October 2014 must be stated on entry form.

SENIOR JUNIOR:

To have reached 14th birthday but under the age of 18 years as of 1st October 2014

YOUNG JUNIORS:

To have reached 11th birthday but under the age of 14 years as of 1st October 2014.

EXTRA YOUNG JUNIORS

Must be eight years or over as of the day of their first qualifying event, but under 11 years as of 1st October 2014

DRESS Smart Marathon Dress and equipment to be used throughout the competition.

THE RESTAURANT

Good food will be available from the restaurant at reasonable prices, from Thursday evening through till end of event Sunday afternoon.

TOILETS & SHOWERS Available within the arena complex, including disabled facilities.

ALL DOGS must be kept on a lead and under proper control at all times whilst attending these Championships. NO DOGS are allowed on the veranda or in the arena's, but may be walked on the Cross Country course. Leave them at home if home care available for them.

THE CROSS COUNTRY COURSE is off limits at ALL TIMES for exercising of horses/ponies. Anyone seen exercising any horse/pony on this area will be asked to leave the showground and will be eliminated from the Championship.

It is a condition of entry that the showground and arena complex is left in a clean and tidy condition.
