The following services are provided by The College EC and **MUST be booked direct with The College EC and in advance of the Championships.** You will require the following details: Card/payment details – vehicle registration/details

**STABLING** There are a limited number of permanent all have rubber matting (yard opposite side of road) plus temporary (in adjacent field) stables available at College EC and must be arranged direct.

**See booking form.**

*Stables will usually be available from 13.30hrs THURSDAY unless otherwise previously arranged. No bedding WILL BE IN YOUR STABLE. The College EC reserves the right to charge additionally for stable use before or after these times – please check. On arrival please park in main car park; do not off load until you have checked in with the Stable Manager. A stable plan will be posted. (Usually on office window and notice board on the veranda) Please put your horse only in the stable you are allocated. Bedding will be either delivered to your box or available from a central point. NO PAPER BEDDING on site please. Clear your beds to the muckheap only and put rubbish in bins provided.*

**NO HORSE/PONY MAY BE LEFT IN LORRY/TRAILER OVER NIGHT**

**PORTABLE STABLING & Fenced/Gated corrals.** Portable stabling may be erected in the Horsebox Park Field only. There will be a charge of £40 for portable stabling for the duration of the event. **MUST BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE** with The College. Electric fenced areas must not exceed 12 x 12 feet for one horse/pony. 20 x 12 feet for two horses/ponies.

**NO PORTABLE STABLING TO BE ERECTED ON THE HARD-STANDING LORRY/CAR PARK**

**ELECTRIC HOOKUP POINTS** are available and must be booked in advance direct. **Only one vehicle per hook up.** These are £25 per night (24 hours). If you want to park any other vehicle at these points then you must book another hook up. ALL other vehicles **MUST** be parked within the car/horsebox park. This will be strictly enforced, anyone taking advantage will be asked to leave the showground.

You **MUST** report to the Stable Managers office upon arrival **BEFORE** parking up or you may be asked to move to another position as parking will be tight and must be regulated.

Caravans/living area on horse boxes **MUST** have an up to date **FIRE EXTINGUISHERS** on board and easily accessible.

# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Remember to bring your horse/ponies **Passports**. These will be checked when collecting your competitors pack. Competitors will not be allowed to compete without an up to date **Equine Flu vaccinations** record within the passport.

## **STALLIONS:**

**Must wear a stallion disk on the bridle according to EU legislation.**

## **SMALL PONIES**

Must not exceed 112cm (11 hands). Ponies close to the height limit MUST produce a current height certificate OR note from Veterinary stating size.

**DRESS** Smart Marathon Dress and equipment to be used throughout the competition. Body Protectors MUST be worn during the obstacle phase.

**CONES AND OBSTACLES** may include a bridge.

## **THE RESTAURANT**

Good food will be available from the restaurant at reasonable prices, from Thursday evening through till end of event Sunday afternoon.

## **TOILETS & SHOWERS**

Available within the arena complex, including disabled facilities. **Please leave in a clean condition as you would wish to find them.**

## **ALL DOGS**

**must be kept on a lead** and under proper control at all times at these Championships. NO DOGS are allowed on the veranda or in the arena's, but may be walked on the Cross Country course. Leave them at home if home care available for them.

## **EXERCISING**

There is a massive outdoor arena that can be used for exercising when the event is NOT taking place. Competitors may also use the outdoor arena 30 minutes before their allotted start time for P&P on Friday and Saturday mornings.

THE CROSS COUNTRY COURSE is off limits at ALL TIMES for exercising of horses/ponies. Anyone seen exercising any horse/pony on this area will be asked to leave the showground and will be eliminated from the Championship.

No exercising in the indoor arenas allowed under any circumstances at any time.

**It is a condition of entry that the showground and arena complex is left in a clean and tidy condition.**
