<u>NATIONAL NOVICE QUALIFIER DETAILS ONLY.</u>

START FEES APPLY.

To be eligible to drive as a National Novice in an official Qualifying Class, a driver must have successfully completed all three phases, with a minimum of a three section marathon, at three affiliated Club events.

Competitors must submit a photocopy of a fully completed competence form to the BCd (BHDTA) for ratification prior to taking part in a National Novice qualifier.

Entries must be made on BCd entry form available on website: www.britishcarriagedriving.co.uk

In addition, the entrant must not have: Previously competed at a National or Regional Event unless this was in a Novice qualifying or Club class.

Finished in the top 50% at the National Novice Championships.

Won two National Novice Qualifiers although he/she can retain their National Novice status throughout the season in which this is achieved.

Qualified for the National Novice Championships.

Contravention of the above will result in disqualification. Entrants in National Novice qualifiers must be members of British CD (BHDTA), but BCD Associate or Club Competitor Membership is acceptable.

Stabling details:

Horseboxes must park as directed. Portable stabling welcome.

No paper bedding. SMALL electric fenced areas permitted.

ALL stable bedding and muck MUST be cleared before leaving showground.

<u>Catering</u>: Catering van available on site from Friday night.

<u>Note</u>: It is compulsory for a suitable, properly secured hard hat to be worn by anyone on a carriage or riding at any time. Also whilst driving a motorcycle, motor scooter, quad or any such vehicle, at any time for the duration of the event.

ALL JUNIOR DRIVERS/RIDERS/GROOMS must wear a body protector at all times whilst riding or on a carriage.

Pony/Horse Passports with up to date vaccinations must be available for inspection upon arrival at showground. NO unvaccinated horse/pony allowed on the showground at any time
