

How to post pictures on the hdt forum

You can put small pictures in your posts on the hdt forum.

Put exactly this in your post wherever you want a picture.

```
\image{Text description}
```

replacing text description with a description of the picture. When you post it will ask you to upload. (The preview will show a placeholder).

You can type it in or paste that piece of text in from the slash to the curly brackets from this note. Files must be on your PC, jpg or gif and 100kb or less.
