The following services are provided by The College EC and MUST be booked direct and in advance of the Championships.

You will require the following details:

Card/payment details – Lorry/tow vehicle registration – make and colour.

STABLING

There are a limited number of permanent (yard opposite side of road) plus temporary (in adjacent field) stables available at College EC and must be arranged direct. Bedding is available up to Thursday evening @ 9pm. If you arrive later than this and have not arranged bedding then please bring your own. Further bedding can be purchased from the office during the Championships.

PORTABLE STABLING

Portable stabling may be erected in the Horsebox Park Field only. There will be a charge of £20 for portable stabling for the duration of the event. Parking area MUST BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE with The College EC.

ELECTRIC HOOKUP POINTS

Hook ups are available and must be booked in advance direct. **Only one vehicle per hook up.** These are £45 for the duration of the event. If you want to park any other vehicle at these points then you must book another hook up. ALL other vehicles MUST be parked within the car/horsebox park. This will be strictly enforced, anyone taking advantage will be asked to leave the showground.

You MUST report to the Stable Managers office upon arrival BEFORE parking up or you may be asked to move to another position as parking will be tight and must be regulated.
