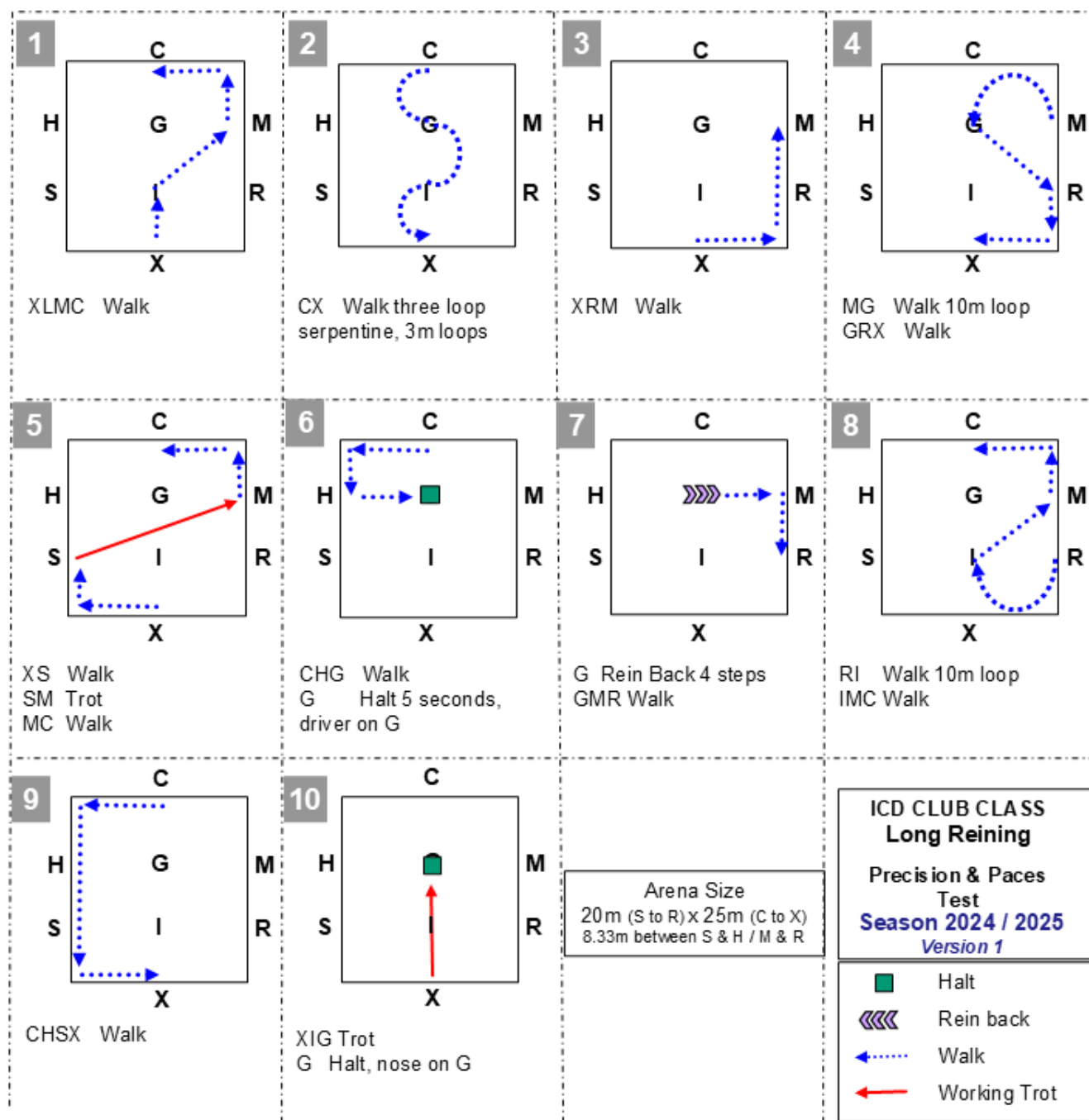

GUIDANCE

- Workmanlike dress, including gloves and suitable protective hat for driver and groom
- A capable attentive groom is required, positioned close by to give assistance and must carry a lead rope
- Driving aids are optional
- Regional Organisers must be consulted before bringing a colt or stallion
- Horses, Ponies & Donkeys must be 3 yrs or older
- Handlers of colts & stallions must be over 16yrs and wear white ribbons on their left arm
- Open or blinkered bridles; bit-less bridles or smart fitting head-collars are accepted
- Colts & stallions must wear bitted bridles and must have a white ribbon in their tail
- A roller or driving harness is required
