BRITISH INDOOR CARRIAGE DRIVING CHAMPIONSHIP

5 - 7 April 2019. The College Equestrian Centre, Keysoe, Bedfordshire. MK44 2JP

Thank you for your entry for this Championship. Again, we have a large entry. PARKING WILL BE TIGHT, so please park in a sensible, orderly fashion. <u>PLEASE FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE PARKING MANAGER</u>.

The ICD Event office will be in the Judges Box to the right of the large outdoor arena. You can collect your information pack Thursday between 4 &7 pm, or Friday morning after 9am, or Saturday morning after 7.30am.

HORSE/PONY PASSPORTS will be checked when you collect your pack. Please book mark the vaccination pages for easy access. Please help make this much quicker and avoid shocks/uncertainty on arrival by sending us a legible scan of your horse vaccination pages by email or to the postal address below to be signed off by ICD office before the event. You could take a picture with your mobile phone and send it.

Any competitor unable to produce the Equine Passport with up to date vaccination record for the horse/pony competing will NOT BE ABLE TO COMPETE or stay at the venue. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Please note the following:

- No competitor may arrive on site before 1330 hours Thursday 4th April 2019 unless previously arranged with the Championship Secretary/The College EC
- No competitor shall block any emergency entrance/exit.
- A good width roadway must be maintained between the rows in the lorry park AND in the parking/corralling paddock.
- Caravans/living area on horse boxes MUST have an up to date FIRE EXTINGUISHERS on board and easily accessible.
- Electric fenced areas must not exceed 12 x 12 feet for one horse/pony. 12 x 20 for two or four Small Ponies.
- No exercising in the indoor arenas allowed under any circumstances at any time.
- There is a massive outdoor arena that can be used for exercising when the event is NOT taking place.
- Competitors <u>ONLY</u> may use the outdoor arena <u>30 minutes before</u> their allotted start time for P&P and cones on Friday and Saturday mornings.
- There is **NO WATER** available in the parking area. Water taps are situated on the veranda by the ladies toilets plus another water tap near the main horse entrance to the Indoor Arena. Neither is accessible with a motor vehicle.
- Competitors who have booked hookups: please check your allocated hookup before parking with the ICD Event office.

The Carriage Driving Development Scholarship for Novice Drivers. This is through the generosity of an anonymous sponsor, who wishes to promote the skills and art of carriage driving.

The Scholarship will consist of Five Driving Sessions with a UKCC Level 2 or 3 Coach in your area.

There are three scholarships available at this year's ICD Championship Finals, open to all drivers in the three Novice Classes. Information will be in all Novice Competitors Packs. There is no entry fee for this scholarship.

<u>IF YOU HAVE BOOKED A STABLE.</u> (From College EC Rules & Regs: NOT ours)

Stables will be available from 4pm THURSDAY – not before. No bedding WILL BE IN YOUR STABLE. The College EC reserves the right to charge additionally for stable use before or after these times – please check. On arrival please park in main car park; do not off load until you have checked in with the Stable Manager. A stable plan will be posted. (Usually on office window and notice board on the veranda) Please put your horse only in the stable you are allocated. Bedding will be either delivered to your box or available from a central point. NO PAPER BEDDING on site please. Clear your beds to the muckheap only and put rubbish in bins provided.

NO HORSE/PONY MAY BE LEFT IN LORRY/TRAILER OVER NIGHT

<u>THE RESTAURANT</u> will be open for the whole weekend, including Thursday from 5pm, Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 7:30am, food is good. There are showers and toilets on site. Several Trade Stands will be on site for those bits you have forgotten!
