Equine Health Status Declaration for Competition V1

Please agree to the following statement:	The horse(s) will not travel to an event should their temperature readings be above 38.5°C.	

In addition, your horses must have up to date equine flu vaccinations – boosted yearly. It is recommended, but not compulsory for ICD, to have a flu vaccination within the 6 months and 21 days before an event, but not within 7 days of the event.
