## Equine Health Status Declaration for Competition V1

<b>Please confirm the following statements:</b>	<p>The horse(s):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● is not under current investigation for infectious diseases including, for example, Equine Herpes Virus (EHV), Equine Influenza, Strangles.</li> <li>● has not been in contact with and is not kept on the same premises as a horse known to have or be under investigation for the neurological form of EHV, Equine Influenza, Strangles or Equine Viral Arteritis.</li> </ul>
<b>Please agree to the following statement:</b>	The horse(s) will not travel to an event should their temperature readings be above 38.5°C.

In addition, your horses must have up to date equine flu vaccinations – boosted yearly. It is recommended, but not compulsory for ICD, to have a flu vaccination within the 6 months and 21 days before an event, but not within 7 days of the event.

If unsure about your horse’s health for competition, please seek veterinary advice rather than risk them and others.
